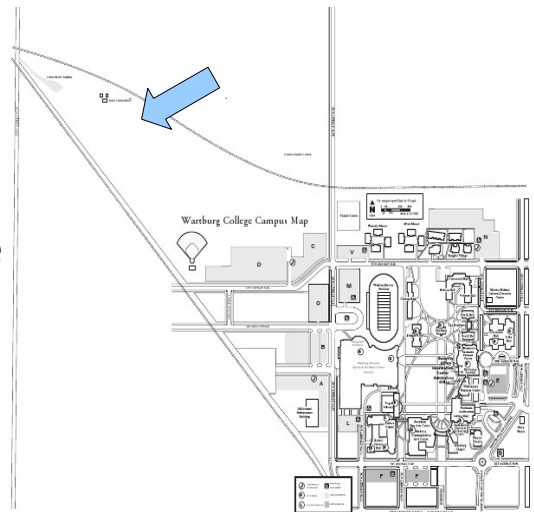


YOU'RE INVITED TO THE MONTHLY OPEN HOUSE AT THE WARTBURG OBSERVATORY!

WHAT: Visit the Wartburg Observatory and learn about the night sky! You can see planets, stars, and nebulae through our telescopes, learn some constellations, or hear about some of the latest interesting astronomy news.

WHEN: Second Saturday of the Month between 7:00PM and 10:00PM. (in case of bad weather, Wartburg Nights will be postponed until the following Saturday)

WHERE: The Observatory is located in Hertel Field, northwest of the corner of 12th St W and 5th Ave N, Waverly. Parking is available at the Hertel Field parking lot, as well as off 20th St NW between the railroad tracks. Look for the red observatory lights in the middle of the field!



WHAT SHOULD I BRING: A flashlight, an empty bladder (sorry, no restroom facilities), a jacket (since it gets cooler in the evening), and an interest in the skies!
